What is the MYGolf National Skills Challenge & Awards Programme?

The MYGolf Skills Challenge is a framework for assessing the progress of boys and girls aged 8-16 years as their golf skills develop. The program mantra is designed to develop the six key skills of the game, being:

Rip It – Driving & Long Shots

Fly It – Pitching

Roll It – Putting

Blast It – Bunker Shots

Chip It – Chipping

Bend It – Manoeuvring the Ball

These skills are tested across five graded levels in each of three main award categories called: Bronze, Silver and Gold.

How much does it cost to enrol in the programme?

A one off joining fee of **\$33.00** per child is charged by the MYGolf Centre (RHGC Pro Shop) and paid to Golf Australia which goes towards the costs of producing the resources that your child receives. The fee for the development programme will be **TBC**.

How long does the programme run for?

The programme is run over 10 week blocks and will be launched on **TBA**

How does my child join MYGolf?

Your child can only join the program through the RHGC Pro Shop (accredited MYGolf Centre)

Who delivers the programme?

AAA PGA Professional Daniel Blackwell will run the programme. Daniel is the Tasmanian Junior Boys & Girls Teams Coach and has plenty of experience delivering the game to children of all ages to make their time learning this great game as fun and exciting as possible.

How long will it take for a Member to progress through the Skills Challenge?

The Skills Challenge provides an entry point and pathway into the game of golf. There is no set length of time to progress through the Skills Challenge. This is dependent upon the age of the Member, how much they want to learn and practice, and their individual ability.
